

Island Advisory Council Meeting of January 21, 2009

Location: CBITD Meeting Room at 4PM – 5PM

Present: Mike Murray, Island Liaison; Fireboat Captain, Cliff Island, Cushing Island and Peaks Island: Rob Tiffany

An update on the annual Deer management program was provided with 11 deer taken from Cushing, 4 from Peaks and 2 from Cliff. The program will most likely end by January 30th if not sooner.

The new fireboat is currently due for completion and arrival in April. There has been some slippage in the schedule due to some design changes being made while in the building process. The Cavalaro will still be in service.

Captain Pendleton announced that monthly training for the Peaks Patrol has commenced. The first month's training will be in the EMS area and the next month's training will be on fire procedures.

While not yet fully confirmed, it is believed that the former Jordan's Meats building will be taken down this Spring. Once demolished, a surface parking area would be created which would have a capacity of between 70-100 vehicles. Further details such as confirmation of this, capacity and pricing will be available over the coming months.

A letter will be going out to all Cliff and Diamond Island residents in February reminding them of the need to register their vehicles and golf carts. Peaks residents will not be receiving this letter due to the presence of public safety officers. A copy of the letter will be posted on the PIC bulletin board down front.
