

Island Advisory Council Meeting of February 17, 2010

Location: CBITD Meeting Room at 4PM – 5PM

Present: Mike Murray, Island Liaison; Mac McCone and Bob Howard from Cliff Island; Cushing Island, and Rob Tiffany from Peaks Island

The deer management program has been carried out again this winter. Last year, 12 deer were taken from Cushing, 9 from Peaks, 3 from Cliff and 3 from Long. This year, 12 were again taken from Cushing, 7 from Peaks, 4 from Cliff and 2 from Great Diamond. The permit for this program expires on February 28th but with the lack of snow, the program has been ended.

The new Fireboat's repairs have been completed and the boat is back on station in Portland.

A training program to allow islanders to become level 1 EMT's will begin shortly. The training will be held on Cliff Island with the fireboat stopping at each island to pick up the trainees. The training is being conducted by the Portland Fire Department. Currently enrolled are 10 from Cliff Island, 2 from Great Diamond Island, 1 from Chebeague Island and 3 from Peaks Island.
