

Island Advisory Council Meeting of June 17, 2009

Location: CBITD Meeting Room at 4PM – 5PM

Present: Mike Murray, Island Liaison; Nancy Ansheles from Little Diamond Island; and Rob Tiffany from Peaks Island

The current estimated “splashdown” date for the new fireboat is July 2nd. It is estimated two additional months will be required for it to become fully operational due to training and break in cruises.

July 14th is the date for the annual availability of fire extinguisher inspections. For Peaks Island, extinguishers need to be delivered to the fire barn by 8am on July 14th with an envelope containing name, address, phone number and \$4.50 per extinguisher. The preliminary date of August 14th has been set for the annual Island Tour by some Councilors plus heads of the various departments. Times for each island will be announced at a later date.

August 22nd has been set as the date for the household hazardous waste pickup on the city islands. Times for the pickup on each island will be announced later but for Peaks Island, the time will be between 10am to 1pm at the transfer station.

Little Diamond Island has requested assistance with brush clearing. This would entail the city bringing out its big chipper.
