### Residential Parking Permits for Island Residents

**Effective Date: July 1, 2008**

This sticker, displayed on the vehicles rear windshield, exempts residents from time limit restrictions in one and two hour time zones, allowing the resident to park in the one or two hour time zones in their designated residential zone. The sticker is not valid for day or night street maintenance restrictions, at parking meters, no parking zones, overnight parking and during snow bans. Permit holders are still required to comply with all other regulations such as “no parking”, “no stopping” and “loading zones, snow bans and emergency no parking postings etc.”

#### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for a Residential Permit Parking sticker:

Address within the zone must be shown on two of the following:

- Valid Maine drivers license
  1. Students must show valid student I.D.
  2. Military must show military I.D.
- Current vehicle registration
- Lease, recent utility bill, or other document approved by the Parking Manager

If a PO Box Must be Portland PO Box & if both lic & Reg have this then a lease & utility bill must be presented

**All outstanding parking tickets must be paid before any permit can be issued.**

There is no fee for the sticker for those who fit the requirements above.  
There is a \$50.00 fee for out of state license holders who own property in Portland and occupy the home for at least six months each year.

Stickers must be placed in the center of the bottom edge of the rear window. If tinted black window, removable top or cap, place the sticker in the lower driver's side corner of the windshield.

If you are buying a new car or replacing a broken window and need to obtain a replacement sticker, you must bring your old sticker in with you.

#### **To Apply**

Residential parking stickers can be obtained in the Parking Division office, room 20 of City Hall between the hours of 7:30am and 6:30 pm Monday through Friday. The application can be downloaded from the Parking Division Web site <http://www.portlandmaine.gov/parking/resparkg.pdf>.
